WHO IS A GOOD CANDIDATE FOR PMU

Anyone who likes wearing makeup but doesn't like the hassle of applying it every day or several times a day. PMU helps to balance any asymmetry to your face and keep you stress free!

Although Permanent Makeup is suitable for many clients, there is a list of client requirements that clients must read and qualify for prior to booking. Please make sure you are aware of the list prior to arriving for your appointment. This list will be posted on my Facebook, Instagram, and Website.

Permanent Makeup is Not Safe for You If You:

- Are under 18
- Are pregnant or nursing
- Are undergoing chemotherapy
- Have hemophilia
- Have major heart problems or a pacemaker
- Have had an organ transplant
- Have uncontrolled high blood pressure
- Have diabetes (consult your doctor as it may be possible)
- Have psoriasis, eczema, rosacea, or other skin conditions in the area
- Have an auto-immune disease (consult your doctor as it may be possible)
- Have anemia (pigment may not be retained properly)
- Have a history of keloid scarring or hypertrophic scarring
- Take blood-thinning medication
- Take Accutane or steroids

Please Note:

If you have ever had cold sores/herpes on the lips, you will need to take special medications 2 weeks leading up to your lip tattoo treatment. Otherwise the tattooing will make your herpes flare up and may lead to loss of pigment or even scarring.

If you are to consult your doctor on any of the above, please have a doctor's note with signature to proceed with treatment.

If you have any concerns or questions about if you can do PMU please consult your doctor beforehand.
